

General Terms and Conditions

1. The promoter is: East End Community Foundation (charity no 1147789) whose registered office is Jack Dash House, 2 Lawn House Close, London, E14 9YQ.
2. The competition is open to residents of the United Kingdom aged 12 years or over except employees of East End Community Foundation and their close relatives and anyone otherwise connected with the organisation or judging of the competition.
3. There is no entry fee and no purchase necessary to enter this competition.

5. Only one entry will be accepted per person. Multiple entries from the same person will be disqualified.
6. Closing date for entry will be 31st May 2017. After this date the no further entries to the competition will be permitted.
7. No responsibility can be accepted for entries not received for whatever reason.
8. The promoter reserves the right to cancel or amend the competition and these terms and conditions without notice in the event of a catastrophe, war, civil or military disturbance, or any actual or anticipated breach of any applicable law or regulation or any other event outside of the promoter's control. Any changes to the competition will be notified to entrants as soon as possible by the promoter.
9. The promoter is not responsible for inaccurate prize details supplied to any entrant by any third party connected with this competition.
10. By entering this competition, an entrant is indicating his/her agreement to be bound by these terms and conditions.
